Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of a contract for visual collaboration platform software licensing and maintenance services with Insight Public Sector Inc. d/b/a Insight Public Sector, for up to three years for a total contract amount not to exceed \$700,000.

Funding in the amount of \$198,204 is available in the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Operating Budget of Communications and Technology Management. Funding for the remaining contract term is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Multiple cooperative purchase programs were reviewed for these goods and services. The Financial Services Department has determined this contractor best meets the needs of Communications and Technology Management to provide these goods and services required for the City.

Additional Backup Information:

The contract will provide visual collaboration platform software licensing and maintenance services. The software is an online digital visual workspace environment that creates a unique space for teams in different locations throughout the City to come together. It allows individuals from multiple departments to work together in real-time on a wide variety of high-functioning white boards and projects through the planning and execution phases. This saves time on travel and scheduling as well as providing a secure platform to protect data without needing to be in a physically secure location.

The Omnia Partners cooperative is a cooperative purchasing association recognized under Texas procurement statutes. Cooperative associations, themselves or using a lead government, competitively solicit and award contracts that are eligible for use by other qualified state and local governments. Due to their

substantial volumes, larger than any one government could achieve independently, cooperative contracts routinely include superior terms, conditions, and pricing. Use of cooperative contracts also results in lower administrative costs and time savings.
