- At this time, all LSU videos have been added to the library.



Active Bystandership for Law Enforcement (ABLE)

Current Status

- APD has been formally accepted to the ABLE Project.
- We have 4 instructors enrolled in Train the Trainer Courses, and will have at least 4 more as dates become available early 2024.
- Our first ABLE Classes will be held starting January 2024, as a part of the Intermediate licensure course, and to the broader Department.
- We expect to have 7 ABLE certified instructors by Q3 FY24, with the eventual goal of 12-15 across the Department by FY25.

Limitations

- Our original ABLE facilitator has reduced the amount of support they are able to provide APD in our ABLE roll-out. This has extended our roll-out timeline from approx. 18mo to 2.5-3yrs.
- APD remains committed to properly and efficiently implementing the ABLE program to 100% of Sworn staff.
