Resolution #20230126-054 Deliverable Due Date Extension Request for CIUR 2631

On January 26, 2023, City Council passed resolution #20230126-054, which directs the Interim City Manager to analyze elements of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework's 23 Targets with the goal of aligning Strategic Direction 28 (SD28) and relevant existing and proposed plans with applicable elements of the 23 targets. The purpose of this memorandum is to request additional time to discuss the results of this analysis with departments whose plans were analyzed as part of CIUR 2631. These plans and departments are:
