Recommendation 20231003-004: Parking Minimums

- Support adoption of the draft ordinance
- Changes
 - Remove references to minimum bicycle parking in Appendix A
 - Require that planned parking provide bicycle parking based on the mode share goals of the Austin Strategic Mobility Plan (5% biking, 50% commuters driving alone)
 - Commercial uses: 2 spaces or 10%
 - Multi-family: 5 spaces or 10%
