SUBJECT: Staff Update to Resolution regarding No. 20221027-039 Tenant Notification and

Relocation

On October 27, 2022, Council passed Resolution No. 20221027-039 initiating amendments to the Tenant Notification and Relocation Ordinance (City of Austin Land Development Code Section 25-1-712) including updates to the 1) notification and relocation requirements and 2) site development regulations. This memo is to confirm that on August 31, 2023, Council adopted an ordinance amending City Code Title 25 (Land Development) related to tenant notification and relocation requirements that apply when property is redeveloped. The amendments will:

- 1. Deter the displacement of residents before submitting for an application; and
- 2. Require compliance with the ordinance when the property owner conducts unpermitted work; and
- 3. Require notifications for tenants for alterations or repairs described in Section 25-1-712(A);
- 4. Require that tenant relocation requirements apply to any multi-family property with five or more residential units.

Resolution No. 20221027-039 also initiated amendments to Chapter 25-2 to amend the site development regulations for mobile home parks to preserve mobile home parks as long-term residential uses, such as increasing the minimum number of days for residential stays. The Planning Department will take that part of the resolution through the amendment process by the end of December 2024.
