Posting Language

Authorize execution of a contract for hauling services for heavy electric utility equipment with H. Brown, Inc., for up to three years for a total contract amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.

Fiscal Note

Funding in the amount of \$555,556 is available in the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Operating Budget of Austin Energy.

Funding for the remaining contract term is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Purchasing Language:

The Financial Services Department issued an Invitation for Bids (IFB) 1100 DCM1061REBID for these services. The solicitation was issued on July 31, 2023, and closed on August 31, 2023. Of the three offers received, the recommended contractor submitted the lowest responsive offer. Additional Backup Information:

This contract will provide Austin Energy with hauling services throughout the Austin Energy Service Area. The contract will also service areas where Austin Energy maintains electric generation, transmission, distribution,

substation, and other facilities. The contractor will provide cranes, tractors, trailers, escort vehicles, dollies, and other labor and equipment as needed to transport heavy electrical equipment, such as power transformers, power transmission poles, mobile substation, and switchgear. The weight of the equipment to be transported will range from 40,000 to 850,000 pounds.
