Authorize negotiation and execution of a contract for situational awareness and operational awareness visualization software maintenance, upgrades, and related services with Primate Technologies, Inc., for up to five years for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,330,000.

[Note: Sole source contracts are exempt from the City Code Chapter 2-9B (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program); therefore, no subcontracting goals were established].

Additional Backup Information:

This contract will provide Austin Energy with the proprietary software, Primate software, as well as upgrades, maintenance, and support services. Primate software is a computer-generated video solution with real time supervisory control and data acquisition that will provide control room-enhanced situational awareness and visualizations projected on a video wall located at Austin Energy's System Control Center. This display allows operators to have an overview of electrical transmission and distribution models while minimizing manual intervention and allowing them to monitor alerts and alarms and other related functions, supporting the management of the distribution and transmission grid. The functionality of this software will enhance operational effectiveness and safety for Austin Energy's field employees.

Primate software is in compliance with North American Electric Reliability Corporation standards, security

policies, business continuity, and disaster recovery plans.

Primate Technologies, Inc. is the sole provider of the Primate software and its enhancements, extension, services, and maintenance and has no other authorized resellers.
