# Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of a contract for the purchase and installation of industrial high volume low speed fans with Heat Transfer Solutions, Inc., for a term of one year in an amount not to exceed \$167,000.

# Additional Backup Information:

This contract will provide for the purchase and installation of high-volume, low-speed (HVLS) overhead and directional fans for two Fleet Mobility Service Centers. HVLS fans are large ceiling fans specifically designed to move a large volume of air at a low rotational speed, and will provide an energy-efficient solution for temperature regulation in Fleet Mobility Service Centers through enhanced air circulation, temperature control, improved ventilation, effective dust and debris management, and reduced noise levels. These cost-effective, energy-efficient fans will significantly contribute to the health and safety of employees, creating a more comfortable, safe, and productive work environment.

This is a new contract. The requested authorization amount is based on the total cost of equipment including installation services.

The Texas Association of School Boards, Inc. (Buyboard) cooperative is a cooperative purchasing association recognized under Texas procurement statutes. Cooperative associations, themselves or using a lead government, competitively solicit and award contracts that are eligible for use by other qualified state and local

governments. Due to their substantial volumes, larger than any one government could achieve independently, cooperative contracts routinely include superior terms, conditions, and pricing. Use of cooperative contracts also results in lower administrative costs and time savings.

A delay in approving this contract could impact comfort and safety improvements and possibly reduce productivity in the work space.
