# Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of a contract with HousingWorks Austin to perform work related to research, data collection, reporting, and engagement initiatives in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 for an initial one-year term, with two additional one-year extensions not to exceed \$100,000 each, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$300,000.

### Fiscal Note

Funding in the amount of \$100,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2023-24 Operating Budget of the Housing Department. Funding for the optional contract extensions is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

### Prior Council Action:

March 24, 2022 - Council authorized negotiation and execution of a 12-month contract with HousingWorks Austin to perform work related to research, data collection, reporting, and engagement initiatives in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.

March 4, 2021 - Council authorized negotiation and execution of a 12-month contract with HousingWorks Austin to perform work related to research, data collection, reporting, and engagement initiatives in an amount not to exceed \$100,000. The contract was for the Fiscal Year 2021-22.
