



Austin Parks and Recreation Department Proposition B Update

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Background

- City of Austin Special Election held November 2, 2021 included Proposition B asking voters to consider if the City of Austin should convey or lease the parkland property commonly referred to as the CMC if the following conditions are satisfied:
 - Exchange of a minimum 48 acres of waterfront land contiguous to an existing City park;
 - The cost or construction of a new maintenance facility for the Parks and Recreation Department (“PARD”) on other city-owned land; and
 - Partial or full funding for the removal of the Fiesta Garden’s existing maintenance facility and restoration of that land to parkland.
 - Requires the value of the conditions described to be equal or greater than the fair market value to the CMC property
- Voters approved 73% to 27% to convey, lease or sell land through a public bidding process.
- The public solicitation was issued on November 15, 2021 and closed December 9, 2021.

Central Maintenance Compound Property

- 2525 S. Lakeshore Blvd.
- Built in 1980s
- Deteriorating working conditions
- Functionally challenging



Responsive Offer

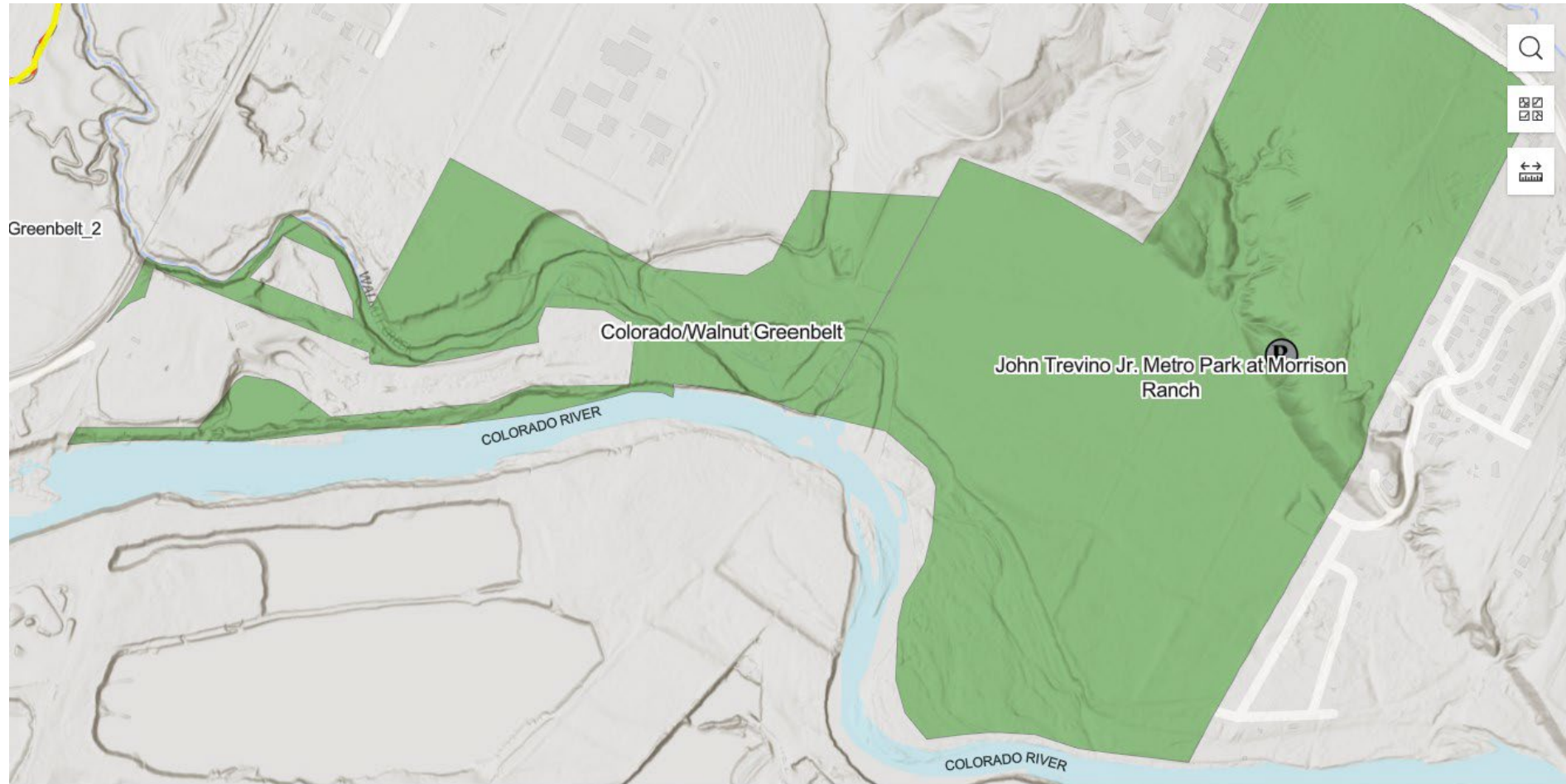
- Convey 50.2 acres of parkland located at 8400 Delwau Lane
- Commitment to build a maintenance compound to replace the CMC Facility and Fiesta Gardens Maintenance Facility
- Commitment to \$1 million to restore Fiesta Gardens grounds
- Responsive offer is a minimum \$37.5 million

Responsive offer from Oracle in its totality satisfies the voter approved Proposition B criteria

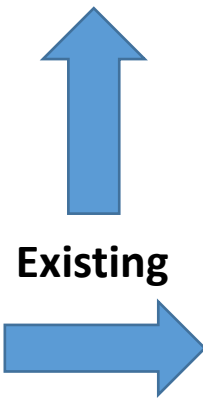
