ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The Parks and Recreation Department applied for and was awarded a Outdoor Recreation Legacy Partnership program grant to replace the existing pool at Montopolis Neighborhood Park. The grant will allow PARD to complete the full preferred concept arrived at through community engagement despite construction cost escalation pressures.

The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, the department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
