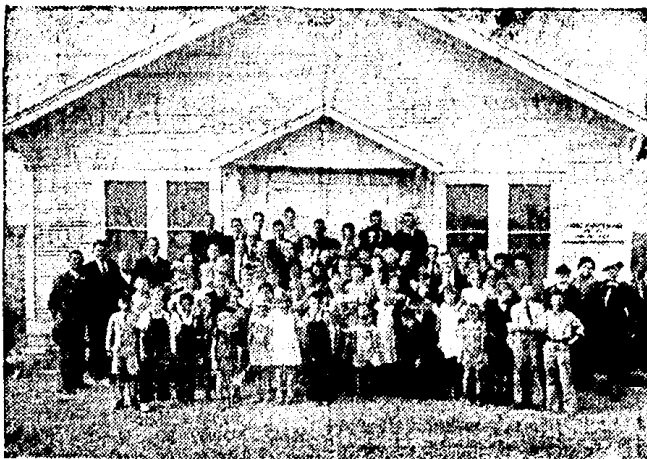

Rev. J. L. Holcomb, lately of Fort Worth, has been called to serve as pastor of newly organized Capitol Heights Baptist church. He accepted the charge.

Rev. Holcomb is a graduate of Baylor university and also holds master's degrees in theology and religious education from the Southwestern Baptist Theological seminary, Fort Worth.

This new Austin Baptist church was organized Sunday afternoon, a number of local and visiting pastors and deacons constituting the council which perfected the organization. The church will be a co-operative Baptist church with the Texas Baptist general convention.

Other church officers elected by the new church were: Mrs. Frank Dwyer, church treasurer; Mrs. J. L. Holcomb, church clerk; R. Huber, deacon.

Plans are being made for the procuring of lots and the erection of an adequate church building in the near future.

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In 1965 the Capitol Heights Baptist Church moved from W. Elizabeth St & Bouldin Ave to become Fairview Baptist Church at 5606 Sth 1st St.

Mission To Open Its Doors

A new Spanish-speaking Baptist mission will open its doors Sunday in South Austin.

El Salvador Baptist Church, under Rev. Elso Garcia, pastor, will occupy a building vacated by the Capitol Heights Baptist Church at 1401 Bouldin.

The mission's first service will be at 11 a.m. Sunday, conducted by Rev. Mr. Garcia, Dr. R. C. Robinson, area missionary for the Baptist Association, Dr. Mildred Boyer, a University of Texas professor, and M. E. Luper, chairman of the Mission Committee of the First Baptist Church, will also take part in the program.

A native of Cuba, Rev. Mr. Garcia has come to Austin from a church in Ballinger to head the mission being sponsored by the Austin Baptist Association and the First Baptist Church.

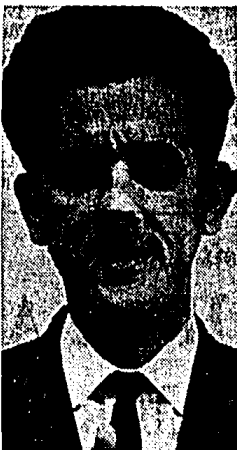
Educated in Cuba, Costa Rica, and Central America, Rev. Mr. Garcia attended the Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth and holds a BA degree from Howard Payne College in Brownwood.

He came to this country 14 years ago, and was with a church in Del Rio before going to Ballinger. He has also preached in six Latin American countries.

Rev. Mr. Garcia said planning for the new mission has gone on for about six months. Although there are two other Spanish-speaking Baptist churches in Austin, El Salvador will be the first one in the South Austin area. The two others are in East Austin.

Sunday's service will be conducted in Spanish, but Rev. Mr. Garcia said English will be spoken in the church's Sunday school and training union.

He also said he soon plans to begin a kindergarten and nursery school, and persons interested in the program are invited to call HT 4-4938.
