ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention grant will provide funding to improve critical public health infrastructure needs. COVID-19 has amplified the resource gap and historically underfunding of public health to meet evolving and complex needs. This grant will enable the Austin Public Health Department to begin to address some critical shortages in epidemiology, public health preparedness, workforce development, Community Health Worker certification and training, and data modernization. This action adds \$1,077,639 to the previously approved Fiscal Year 2023 grant budget of \$11,941,809 for a new total grant award of \$13,019,448.
