1	RESOLUTION NO.
2	WHEREAS, City Council Resolution No. 20170831-060 directed the City
3	Manager to allocate 15 percent of the seven-cent portion of the City's Hotel Occupancy
4	Tax (HOT) to support operations and maintenance of City of Austin historic facilities
5	and sites in accordance with Texas Tax Code Section 351.101(a)(5); and
6	WHEREAS, City Council Resolution No. 20181004-033 directed the City
7	Manager to allocate the Historic Preservation Fund Fiscal Year 2019 budget in the
8	following manner:
9	• 70 percent for City of Austin historic facilities and sites in accordance with
10	Texas Tax Code Section 351.101(a)(5);
11	• 15 percent reserved for potential future historic acquisitions or major
12	preservation projects that would be frequented by tourists and convention
13	delegates; and
14	• 15 percent for the Heritage Grant Program; and
15	The resolution also directed the City Manager to:
16	• expand the eligible applicants for heritage grants per the recommendations
17	of the Visitor Impact Task Force and the Heritage Grant Working Group;
18	• expand eligible projects for Heritage Grants to include capital projects and
19	planning, educational, and marketing projects; and

increase the \$59,000 cap on individual Heritage Grant awards to \$250,000 20 with staff discretion to recommend to Council grant requests above this 21 threshold; and 22 WHEREAS, City staff use City Council Resolution No. 20181004-033 as a 23 guide for how to apportion funds in future fiscal years; and 24 WHEREAS, Texas Tax Code Section 351.101(a)(5) authorizes HOT revenue to 25 be used for historic restoration and preservation projects or activities or advertising and 26 conducting solicitations and promotional programs to encourage tourists and 27 convention delegates to visit preserved historic sites or museums: 28 at or in the immediate vicinity of the convention center facilities or visitor 29 information centers; or 30 located elsewhere in the municipality or its vicinity that would be 31 frequented by tourists and convention delegates; and 32 WHEREAS, through Council's approval of the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 City of 33 Austin Budget (Ordinance No. 20230816-008), and the ordinance related to this 34 resolution approved in the same Council meeting as this resolution amending the Fiscal 35 Year 2023-2024 36 City of Austin Budget to increase appropriations to the Economic 36 37 Development Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Historic Preservation 38 Fund, funding in the amount of \$31,723,887 is available in Fiscal Year 2023-2024 to

39	the Economic Development Department for eligible historic restoration and
40	preservation projects and activities;
41	WHEREAS, for nearly two decades, a portion of the Austin Convention and
42	Visitors Bureau (now Visit Austin) budget has been allocated to fund and administer
43	the Heritage Grant Program, and Visit Austin ceased administration of the program at
44	the end of 2018; NOW, THEREFORE,
45	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:
46	The City Manager is authorized to award, negotiate, and execute historic
47	preservation fund grant agreements and allocations for Fiscal Year 2023-24 in an
48	amount not to exceed \$31,723,887 for historic preservation and restoration projects and
49	activities, as recommended by staff.
