ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The additional funds from the Public Health Workforce Grant will continue to ensure a diverse public health workforce is hired, trained, and retained. Funding is provided by the grant for Fiscal Years 2021 to 2024. This grant is in alignment with the Public Health Crisis Response Cooperative Agreement for Emergency Response (Funding Opportunity Number CDC-RFA-TP18-1802) from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (also known as the CDC).
