**SUBJECT:** Update on Land Development Code Amendments directed through Resolution Nos.

20230601-048, 20230601-047, and 20221027-039

This memorandum provides updates regarding several land development code (LDC) amendments managed by the Planning Department.

This memo serves to close out the following resolutions:

- Resolution No. 20230601-048: Approve a resolution initiating code amendments to City Code
  Title 25 related to dwelling unit occupancy limits. City Council adopted code changes responsive
  to this resolution at the City Council meeting on Dec. 7, 2023.
- Resolution No. 20230601-047: Approve a resolution initiating amendments to City Code Title 25 to allow applicants to request changes to Future Land Use Maps (FLUM) at any time. City Council adopted the last portion of the changes required for this resolution at the City Council meeting on Dec. 14, 2023.

It also serves to extend the timeline for the following resolution to December 31, 2024:

 Resolution No. 20221027-039: Approve a resolution relating to mobile homes and tenant notification and relocation requirements; and initiating amendments to Title 25 of the City Code. Additional time is needed due to other code amendments that are underway.

The table includes a description of each amendment, current status, proposed timeline, and the lead department.
