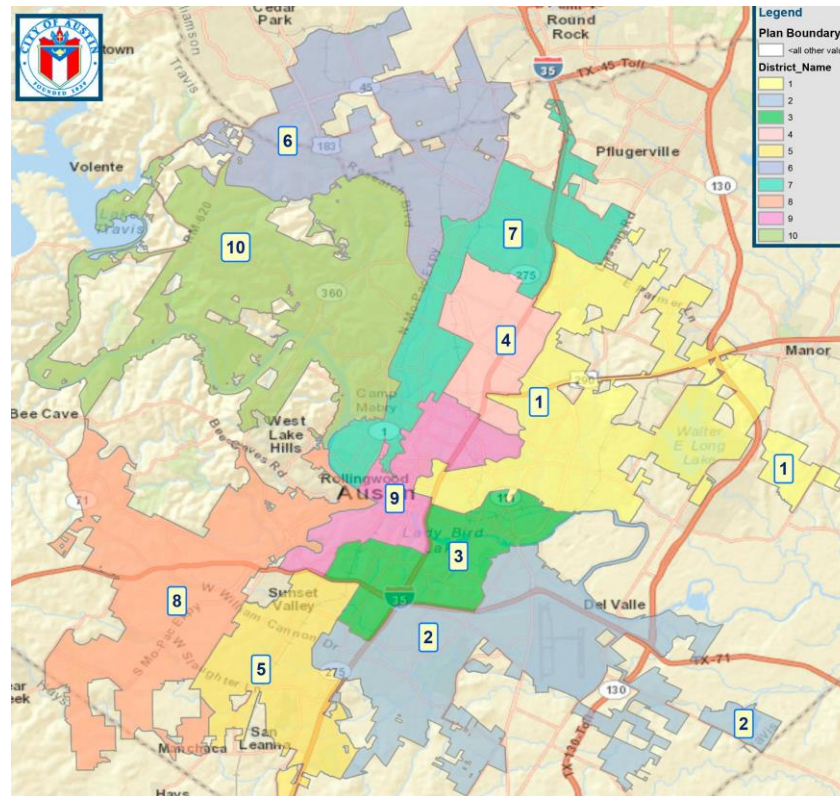

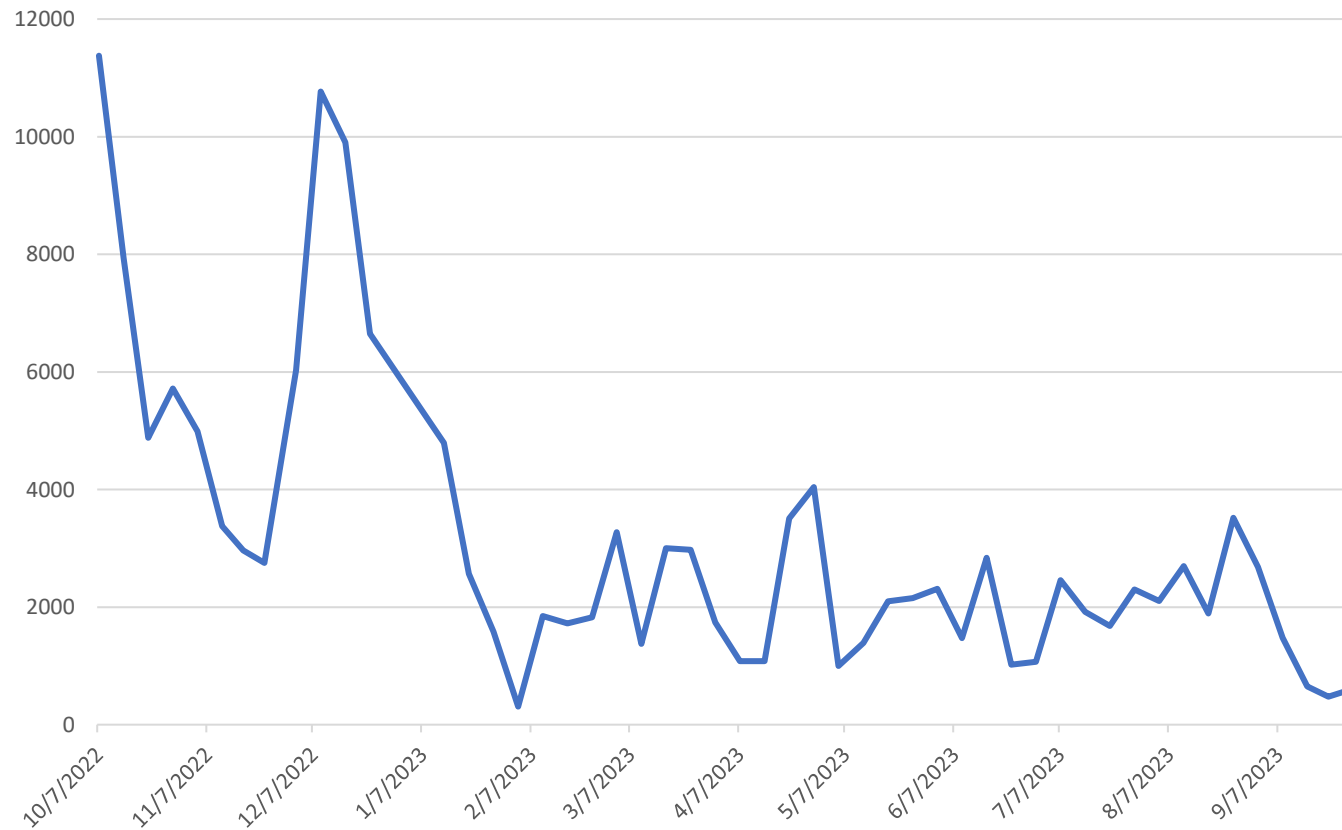

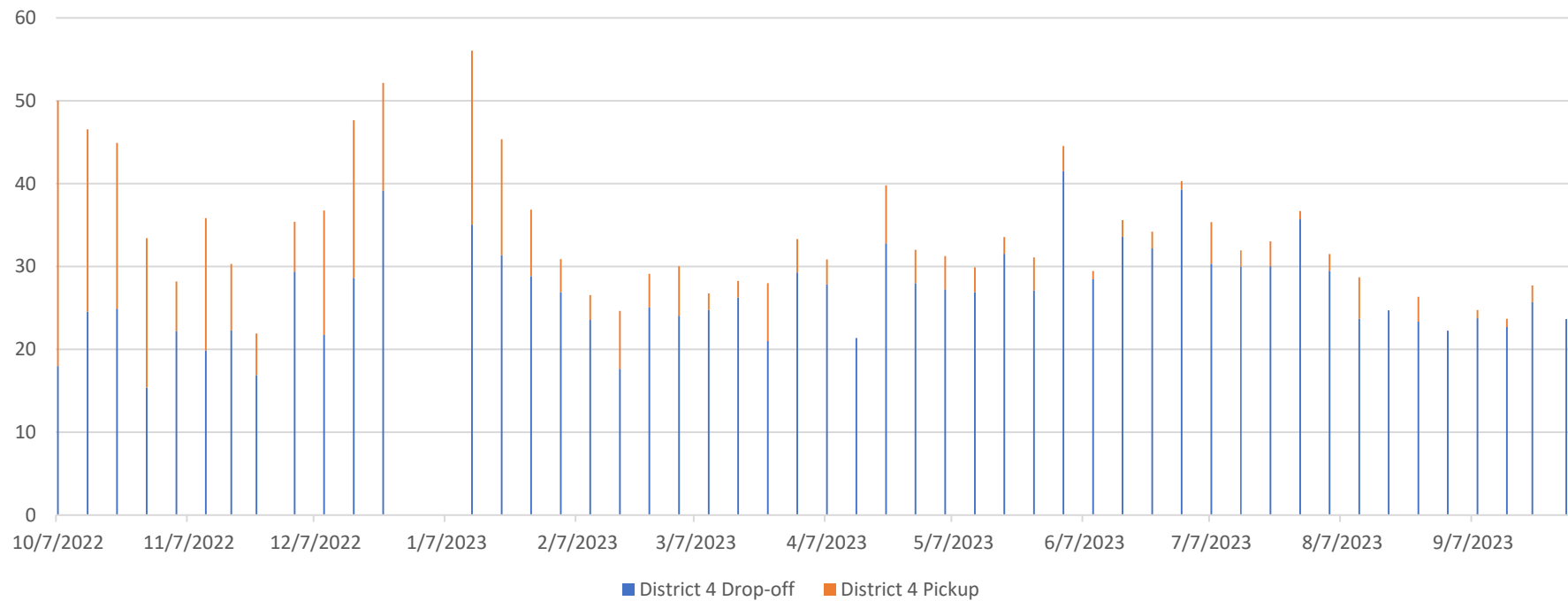
# Weight collected weekly

Total pounds of HHW collected in FY23



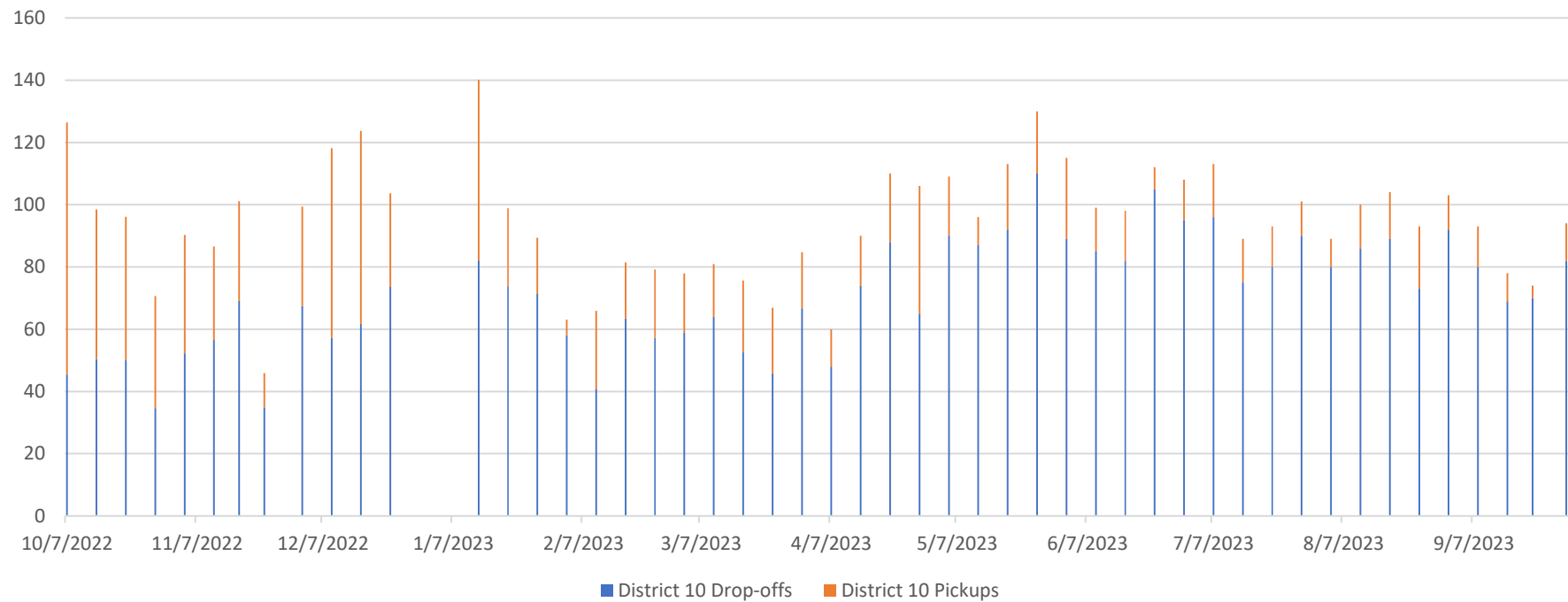
# District 4 pickup and drop-off

District 4 drop-offs and pickups

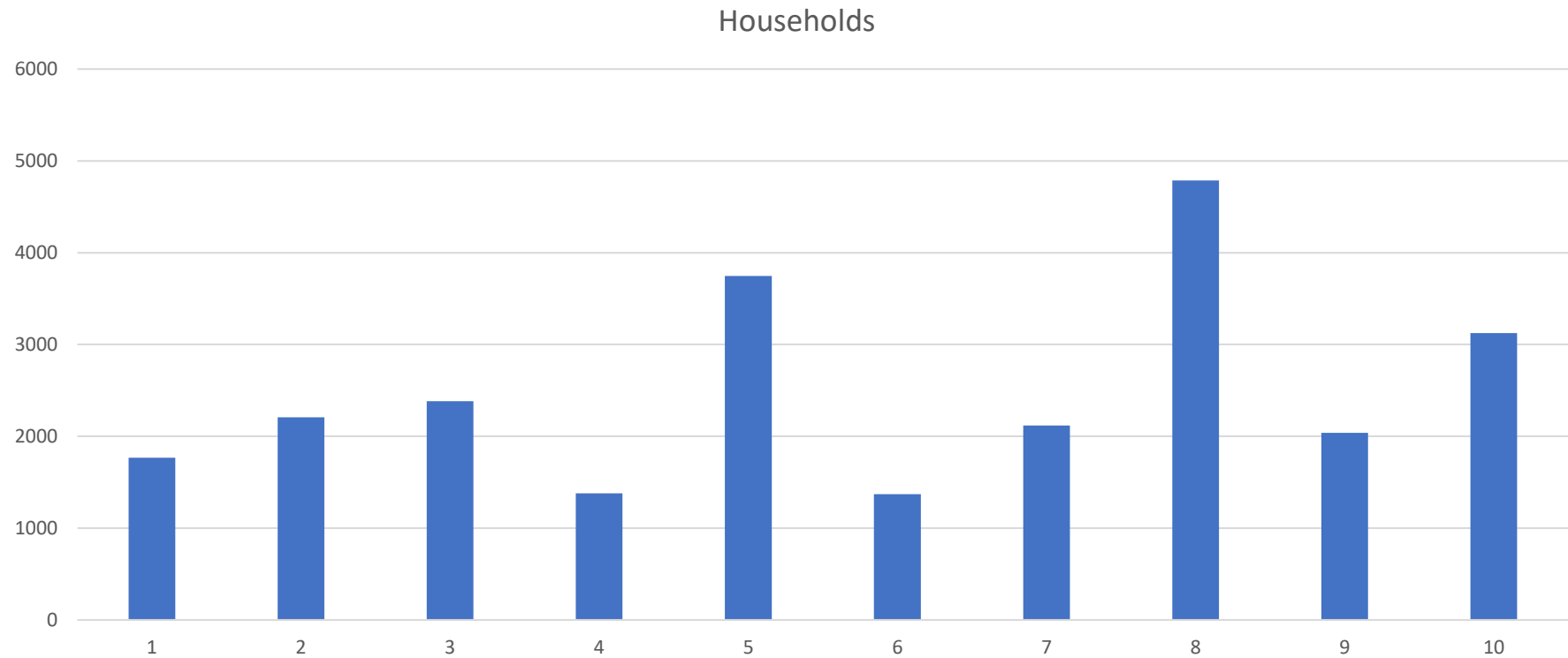


# District 10 pickup and drop-off

District 10 drop-offs and pickups

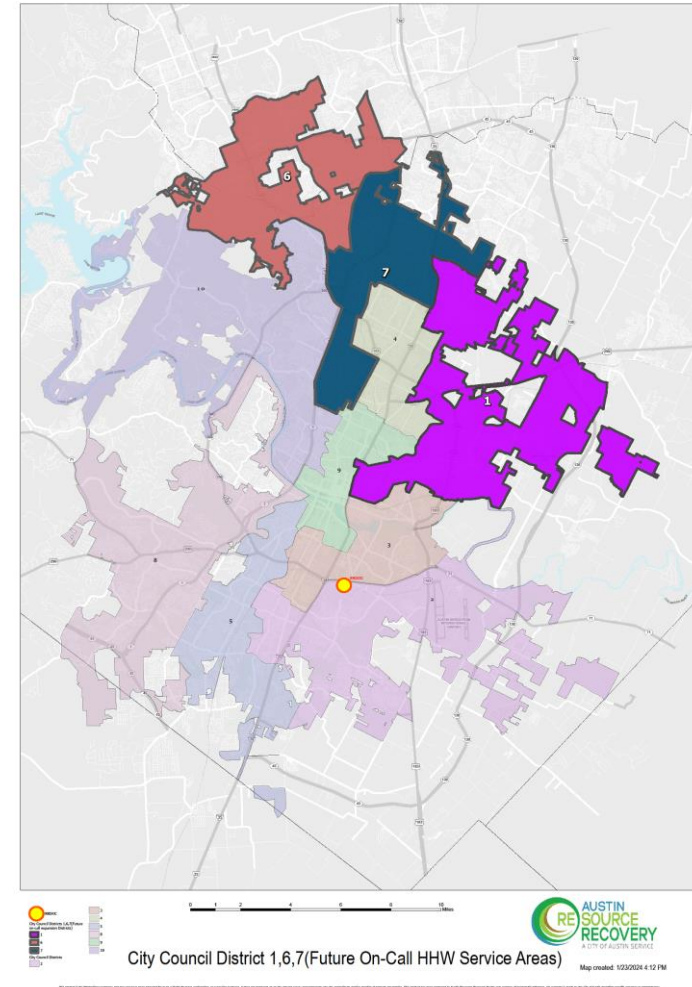


# Drop-offs per district

Beginning September 12, 2022, Austin Resource Recovery is conducting a pilot program to gather information about household hazardous waste (HHW) collection in the City of Austin. This program will be tested in Austin City Council Districts 4 and 10.

It will help the City understand the challenges related to the at-home collection of HHW. It will also allow the City to gauge the usability and benefits of the program.

Recycling and reuse (or proper disposal) of HHW keeps dangerous and harmful materials out of our landfills and the environment. It also reduces pollution, energy use and the consumption of raw materials. If you are in Districts 4 or 10, you can now do this from the comfort of your home. The pilot will last one year.

Although having a new service can feel overwhelming, it doesn't need to be. We can help.
