

## AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

WORK SESSION MEETING TUESDAY, JANUARY 16, 2024

The City Council of Austin, Texas convened in a Work Session Meeting on Tuesday, January 16, 2024, at 301 W. 2nd Street, Austin, TX and via videoconference.
