

RESOLUTION NO. 20240201-028

WHEREAS, on July 20, 2023, Council approved Ordinance No. 20230720-190 (the “Ordinance”) establishing the police reserve force in line with Texas Local Government Code Section 341.012; and

WHEREAS, the police chief has appointed the individual named below to the police reserve force; and

WHEREAS, the appointed member is a licensed peace officer and meets the qualifications and standards established by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement and required in the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Council must approve the appointment in order that the reserve officer has the authority to carry a weapon or otherwise act as a peace officer; and

WHEREAS, the total size of the police reserve force may not exceed 75 members; and

WHEREAS, the police chief may call members into service at any time the police chief considers it necessary to have additional officers to preserve the peace and enforce the law; and

WHEREAS, reserve police officers may, however, act only in a supplementary capacity to the regular police force and may not assume the full-time duties of regular police officers; and

WHEREAS, members of the reserve police force will be temporary employees and serve at the discretion of the police chief; and

WHEREAS, the licensed peace officer appointed by Robin J. Henderson, Interim Chief of Police, is David Hughes; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

Council approves the Interim Chief of Police's appointment of David Hughes to the police reserve force.
