WATER FORWARD One City, One Water: A plan for the next 100 years



Reuse

- Reclaimed Water System: Expanding the reclaimed water system to meet growing non-drinking water needs, such as irrigation, cooling systems, manufacturing, and toilet flushing. ◆ ◆
- Onsite Water Capture and Reuse: Increasing capture and reuse of rainwater, stormwater, graywater, blackwater, and air conditioning condensate onsite at commercial and multifamily properties for non-drinking water purposes. ◆
- New Incentives: Identifying rate options and incentives to support expansion and adoption of the reclaimed water purple pipe system.



Conservation

- My ATX Water: Replacing all analog water meters with digital smart meters for customers to better track water use and identify leaks. ◆
- Incentives: Reducing outdoor water use by encouraging customers to embrace regionally appropriate landscaping and installation of smart irrigation controls. ◆
- **Ordinances:** Setting requirements for landscaping and using irrigation systems for new single-family homes. ◆
- Water Use Benchmarking and
 Budgeting: Estimating water use for
 specific building types and setting budgets
 to achieve those benchmarks. ◆ ◆



Supply

- Aquifer Storage and Recovery: Storing
 Austin's existing water supplies in a natural
 aquifer during plentiful times to be used
 during droughts and emergencies.
- Inflows Capture: Capturing inflows to Lady Bird Lake and treating for drinking water purposes.
- **Groundwater Resources:** Brackish groundwater desalination for integration with Austin's water supply. ◆
- Off Channel Reservoir: Constructing a new large-scale reservoir for water storage. ◆ ◆



Partnerships

- State Water Planning: Actively participating in the Lower Colorado River regional water planning process.
- Lower Colorado River Authority: Collaborating to assess water use, implement water conservation strategies, and ensure water quality for Austin and the surrounding area.
- Imagine Austin Comprehensive Plan:
 Integrating Water Forward strategies to
 address water resource issues such as
 supply, quality, conservation, public health,
 and recreation.
