Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of amendments to two contracts for continued security system parts and labor with Preferred Technologies LLC d/b/a Preferred Technologies and Knight Security Systems LLC, to increase the amounts by \$7,370,000 for revised total contract amounts not to exceed \$7,620,000, divided between the contractors.

[Note: These contracts were reviewed for subcontracting opportunities in accordance with City Code Chapter 2 -9B (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). For the goods and services required for these contracts, there were no subcontracting opportunities; therefore, no subcontracting goals were established].

Additional Backup Information:

These contract amendments will provide continued maintenance and support for the City for security management systems through Genetec. Genetec is an enterprise security management system that combines physical access control, alarm monitoring systems, closed-circuit television, intercom and emergency call stations, employee identification badging, and video surveillance into a single environment, and manages security activities as it relates to deterrence, response, and protection of utility assets.

The contractors provide necessary installation services, maintenance, emergency service, and programming for the access control systems and devices, video surveillance devices, intrusion detection devices, and required software support for the integration and management of the system components.
