







#### **Support for Quality-of-Life Commissions**


- 1: History of Exclusion & Underrepresentation
- 2: Created to help elevate the voices of the most vulnerable & directly impacted communities
- 3: Commissioners are given elevated privilege: Access to City Council & Inclusion in the Budget Process
- 4: Council wants community to come to commissions, and then Commissions to advise Council
