



25 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

26 The City Manager is directed to explore options to amend Section 10-3-26  
27 93(D)(6) of the City Code to update the requirements for the inspection of mobile  
28 food establishments that have a regular, fixed location and a co-location agreement  
29 with an adjacent business to include an option to opt-in for on-site permitting  
30 inspections in the same manner as a brick-and-mortar food establishment that also  
31 complies with the requirement under Section 228.221(a)(3) of Title 25 of the Texas  
32 Administrative Code that the mobile food establishment is readily moveable.

33 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

34 The City Manager is directed to explore and confirm costs for any expanded  
35 staffing and equipment required by Austin Public Health's Environmental Health  
36 Services Division and Austin Fire Department to accommodate this change in  
37 process.

38 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

39 The City Manager is directed to explore options for allowing the use of online  
40 notary services as part of the mobile food establishment permit application process  
41 to minimize the administrative burden on microbusiness owners.

42 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

43 The City Manager is directed to work with the Austin Public Health  
44 Environmental Health Services Division to begin the routine collection of  
45 demographic data for mobile food establishment license holders, and the number  
46 of people they regularly employ.

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48 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

49           The City Manager is directed to bring the available options for City Code  
50 amendments, implementation plan, and staffing costs to Council for its  
51 consideration by the May 30, 2024, meeting.
