



The following are recommendations from our collaborative & diverse conversation:

- \$1.5 M Austin Public Health multi-year allocation to Early Childhood Education and Development funding:
 - \$500,000 Early childhood education and development scholarships
 - Directly dispersed to childcare centers & registered licensed to support parents with high needs
 - \$500,000 Pilot- EC mini-grants providing emergency financial relief for home-based licensed providers and Family, Friend, Neighbor (FFN) caregivers; Center Based Care
 - \$250,000 Health Insurance Support & Navigation for the childcare care workforce:
 - Funding Navigators specifically focused on outreach for childcare providers.
 - Proof Income of income as barrier
 - Limited free time prevents from engaging in already existing navigation support.
 - Health as prevention to bring stability to the childcare workforce
 - 250,000 to establish a lending libaray & resource center for child care providers and families.
- Continued Funding of Family Stabilization Grant Program
 - Funding continued to go through the Equity Office and contracted Uptogether who is reputable nationally and has proven success with the Austin Pilot.
 - A way to support Friend Family Neighbor caregivers, who are not directly supported by programs who target childcare providers.
