

**ORDINANCE NO. 20240307-032**

**AN ORDINANCE REZONING AND CHANGING THE ZONING MAP FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 719 CONGRESS AVENUE FROM CENTRAL BUSINESS (CBD) DISTRICT TO CENTRAL BUSINESS-HISTORIC LANDMARK (CBD-H) COMBINING DISTRICT.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1.** The zoning map established by Section 25-2-191 of the City Code is amended to change the base district from central business (CBD) district to central business-historic landmark (CBD-H) combining district on the property described in Zoning Case No. C14H-2023-0105, on file at the Planning Department, as follows:

0.1579 acres of land, being the north 40 feet of LOT 5 and the south 3 feet of LOT 6, BLOCK 84 of the ORIGINAL CITY OF AUSTIN, in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, according to the map or plat on file in the General Land Office of the State of Texas, and being that same tract of land described by general warranty deed recorded in Volume 12813, Page 1358, of the Official Public Records of Travis County, Texas (the "Property"),


