

AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

WORK SESSION MEETING TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 27, 2024

The City Council of Austin, Texas convened in a Work Session Meeting on Tuesday, February 27, 2024, at 301 W. 2nd Street, Austin, TX and via videoconference.

Mayor Pro Tem Pool called the Council Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Council Members Ellis and Kelly attended virtually. Mayor Watson was absent.

Conduct a public hearing and consider an ordinance amending City Code Title 25 to create a new zoning district for a density bonus program that grants 30 feet in height above the base zone, to a maximum of 90 feet, and modifies site development regulations, including compatibility standards; and initiating rezoning of certain properties.
