Disparity Study

- 2022 Disparity Study –
 Adopted by City Council,
 October 2022
- New MBE/WBE Program
 Ordinance (2-9A and B) Approve by Council July
 2023

Administrative Rules

 Updated Administrative Rules – Adopted December 2023

Inclusive Procurement Working Group

- Made 20 recommendations to improve MBE/WBE Program
 - Ordinance revisions July 2023
 - New Personal Net Worth calculation

SMBR – Events to Date



- New Disparity Study
 - Showed lower MBE / WBE availability
 - Adopted by Council, October 2022
- MBE/WBE Ordinance
 - Updated / revised
 - In response to new disparity study
 - Adopted by Council, July 2023
- Complimentary Procurement Program(s)
 - Council requested examination of other / complimentary program(s)
 - Specifically including local / small business preferences
 - Program(s) to offset lower MBE / WBE availability

Stakeholder Feedback



- Feedback from Meetings and Survey
 - Continue / do not harm existing MWBE Program (strong emphasis)
 - Maintain Local and Small programs separately
 - Equal priority for Local and Small
 - Include preference for Local and Small subcontractors if possible
 - Small status based on SBA Small Size Standard
 - Local status based on Greater Austin
 - Local status based on Headquarters
 - Explore future enhancements to identify Local firms (certification)
 - Concern Program enhancements may not positively impact all groups equally
 - Concern Programs do not apply to Pro Services and most Construction

Program Enhancements – Both



- Began 2-Year Pilot Period (10/01/2023 09/30/2025)
 - Capped both Programs to Solicitations for Contracts below \$50M
 - Monitor and Report on programs performance
 - Control against negative impacts to other programs
 - Determine program elements that may be revised further
- Local Preference Program
 - Revised / streamlined program criteria
 - Optimized preferences where necessary
- Small Business Program
 - Implemented Small Business program elements
 - Mirrored Local Preference program

Local Preference – Enhancements



- Definition of Local Area
 - Was Austin, Full Purpose Jurisdiction only
 - Now Greater Austin (5-County, "Austin-Round Rock-San Marcos, MSA")
- Entity within Local Area
 - Was Headquarters or Branch Office
 - Now Headquarters only

Small Businesses – Enhancements



- Definition of Small
 - Any recognized Cert., that includes SBA Small Business Size Standard
- Small Certifications Recognized
 - Was City of Austin (MBE, WBE, SBE) only
 - Now Added State of Texas, Historically Underutilized Businesses (multiple),
 Federal, Small and Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (multiple)

Both Programs – Excluded Elements



- Will continue to consider excluded elements during pilot
- Subcontractors
 - Excluded from both programs
 - Stakeholder Feedback, avoid negative impacts to MBE/WBE Program
- Construction Services, Over \$100,000
 - Excluded from both programs
 - Statute limits Local preference for Construction
- Professional Services
 - Not included previously
 - o Two (2) Categories

Both Programs – Excluded Elements, Professional Services



- Specified Professional Services
 - O Subject to Texas Gov Code Ch. 2254, and Ch. 2269 (CIP Procurement, State and Local Gov)
 - Includes Architects, Engineers, Surveyors Physicians, Nurses, CPAs, etc.
 - Must be selected based on qualifications and experience only (No IFB, RFP)
- Exempt Professional Services
 - Not subject to Texas Gov Code, Ch. 2269
 - Exempt from Texas Local Gov Code, Ch. 252 (Municipal Procurement, General)
 - Subject to City Charter (Prohibits use of IFB)
 - Includes all manner of Consultants, Advisors, Analysts, Experts, etc.
 - May only be selected based on qualifications and experience (No IFB)
 - Not considered Professional Service if RFP is possible

Both Programs – Current Status

- Adjustments / Observations
 - Adjusted Invitation for Bids (IFB) evaluation method, Best Value (3 Criteria)
 - Calculating preferences is manually intensive, Seeking automated solution

Both Programs – Going Forward, Next Steps



- Continue reviewing Program Numbers and Exclusions
 - Number and percentage of responses from Local and Small offerors
 - Comparison of participation in solicitations with and without programs
 - Continue examining excluded elements for possible options
- Develop Program Awareness and Impact
 - Pursue Vendor outreach for greater awareness and participation
 - Support program recognition from other governments in Greater Austin
 - Determine other certification sources and opportunities
- Program Efficiencies
 - Continue seeking automated solution for calculating preferences
- Next Program Check-Ins and Updates
 - Review FY24 Numbers and Observations (Early CY 2025)

Direction from Council



"To further Council's ongoing commitment to support the City's Minority and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program, the City Manager is directed to explore the development of additional, complementary, procurement programs that will promote further contracting opportunities for small businesses, including but not limited to minority and women owned businesses. Such programs should consider a local preference feature and be presented to council for action before August 31, 2023, so that Council can align their adoption with the implementation of future updates to the disparity study goals for MWBE. As part of the envisioned stakeholder process for developing updated MWBE goals and the above complementary procurement programs, the City Manager is directed to work with the local chambers of commerce to review the 2022 Disparity Study and to identify ways that the City can further support small, local businesses in accordance with race and gender-neutral guidelines offered by past legal assessments."
