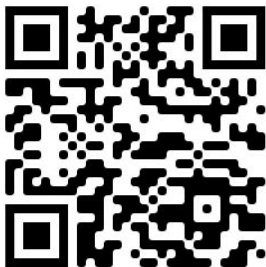
Speaker Donation of Time
