Authorize negotiation and execution of a contract for Doble testing equipment and related services with Doble Engineering Company, for up to five years, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$586,500.

This contract will provide Austin Energy with Doble diagnostic testing equipment, software, and support services utilized in substation maintenance. This equipment is used to evaluate and assess the health of critical assets, including transformers, bushings, and circuit breakers. Austin Energy uses the test results to make decisions about repair, replacement, and operation of these assets.

Doble Engineering Company is the sole provider of these goods and services and only offers them directly to customers without distributors.
