Origins of Thrive Grant

Why Thrive?

- To Build capacity for Austin's current and next generation of arts and culture leaders
- Intentionally strengthen culturally specific organizations
- Develop enforceable accountability systems for organizations





Clarifying Eligibility (all programs)

Creative Businesses (for-profit groups) Eligibility

- Feedback was contradictory
- Individuals and Creative Businesses have always been eligible
- Annual Budget Expense capped
- Non-arts organizations no longer eligible
- Why are non-Austinites allowed to apply for funding?
 - Austin cost of living is expensive
 - Limited to 5-county region (MSA)
 - Over half of their activities must take place in Austin/ETJ
 - All funded activities must take place in Austin/ETJ

Guideline Changes (from Proposed to Present)

Thrive eligibility revised

•Removed the "\$100k or less average COA award over time" eligibility requirement

Revised to be clearer and more concise Reduced the number of questions and required uploads

Panel Process (From Core to Pilot to Present)

Added Equity training for staff and panel members Higher pay for reviewers (training, reviewing/scoring, panels) Added Community Member participation (funds are for community) All multidisciplinary panels (ensuring robust panel participation) No interaction from the public (national grantmaking best practices) Virtual panel meetings (increased equity and flexibility) Added Spanish interpreters

No Reader Stage Added mid-range scoring options





Language Access (From Core to Pilot)

More language access but a work in progress Applications accepted in non-English languages Community Navigator assistance in Spanish Interpreters available upon request Videos are captioned





Award Determination (from Core to Pilot)

Option to accept a smaller award

No matching requirement No minimum score requirement Awards no longer tied to budget size Narrow and deep funding

- Awards are more meaningful
- Community wanted competitive process

- Launch at the same time

Application Assistance (from Core to Present)

- Increased technical assistance and training
- Added Community Navigators/Amplifiers
- More 1:1 support provided
 - Weekly and application due date Open Office Hours
 - No Friday application due dates
 - Deadline moving from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM
 - Staff availability 8:00 AM 6:00 PM generally
