- A place where administrators and teachers are deeply aware of their implicit biases and internalized anti-Blackness and have the skills to disrupt them.








OUR CURRENT REALITY

What else is possible?











- RISE will provide free or low-cost, short-term, culturally congruent, high-quality drop-in child care, designed for Black mothers and their children ages 6 weeks through age 5.
- Team of caregivers, making \$28-\$35 per hour, will be trained in RISE's anti-racist pedagogy
- Every moment matters: this is not babysitting; it is high-quality care even if it is short
- Phase 1: Parents on premises to engage in work, education/training, enjoyment activities or rest.
- Support for parents who need long-term child care
