

**RESOLUTION NO. 20240514-001**

**WHEREAS**, on May 4, 2024, six separate special municipal elections were held in different areas in the City of Austin, on the question of disannexing each of those six areas; only voters registered in an area were entitled to vote on the disannexation of that area and were given the option of voting “for” or “against” the measure on their ballot; and

**WHEREAS**, the returns of the special elections have been made to the Council and show that the votes for and against the propositions were cast as follows:

**Proposition A (Lost Creek)**

**Proposition B (Mooreland Addition)**

**WHEREAS**, a majority of all votes cast in the special elections were cast “For” Propositions A, C, and F; a majority of all votes cast in the special election were cast “Against” Proposition D; and no votes were cast in the special elections on Propositions B and E; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

The Council finds that all of the recitals contained in this resolution are true and adopts them as findings of fact by this governing body; and

The Council finds that the results of the special elections as tabulated, received, and canvassed reflect the votes cast at the election; and

The Council accepts and approves the returns for the special elections, as tabulated, received, and canvassed and with this canvass, Council is making official the precinct returns received from Travis County.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

The Council accepts and approves the returns for the special elections as tabulated, received, and canvassed, and declares that the areas included in Propositions A, C, and F, which are Lost Creek, Blue Goose Road, and River Place

Outparcels, shall be disannexed pursuant to State and City law; and the areas included in Propositions B, D, and E, which are Mooreland Addition, Lennar at Malone, and Wildhorse/Webb Tract, shall remain a part of the City of Austin.
