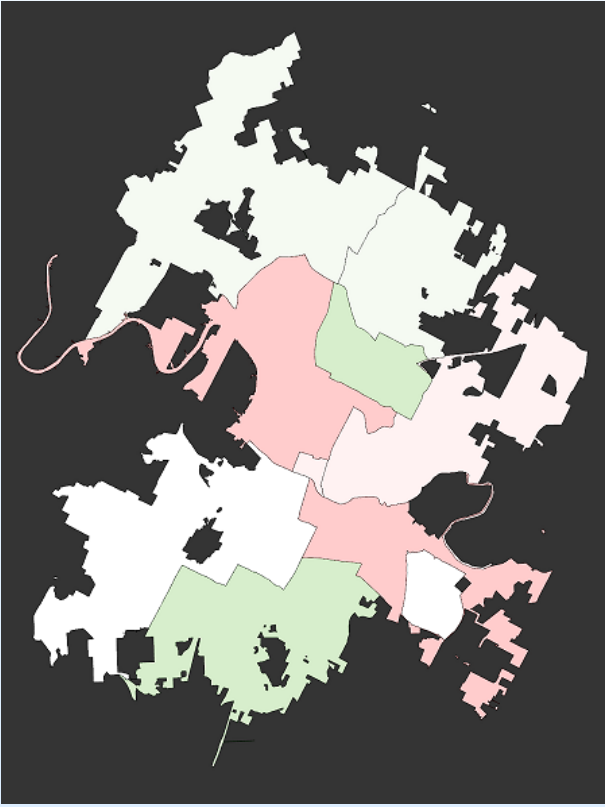

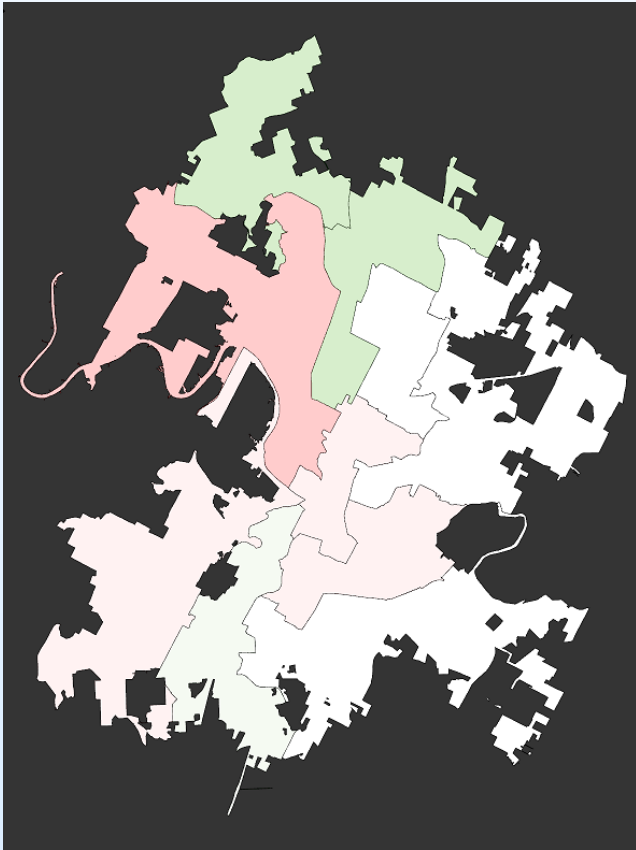

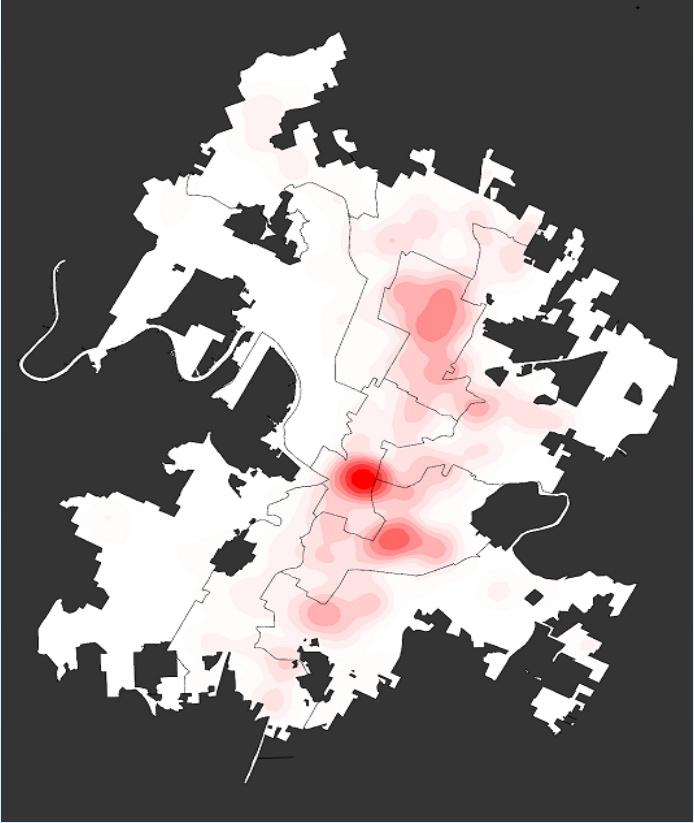

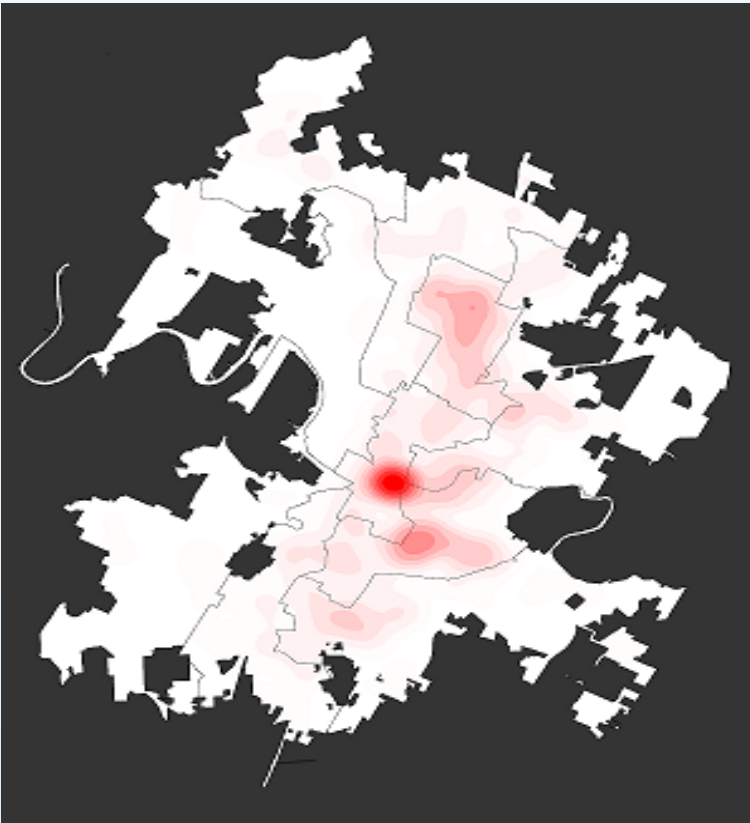


Crimes Against Persons Density (“Hotspots”)

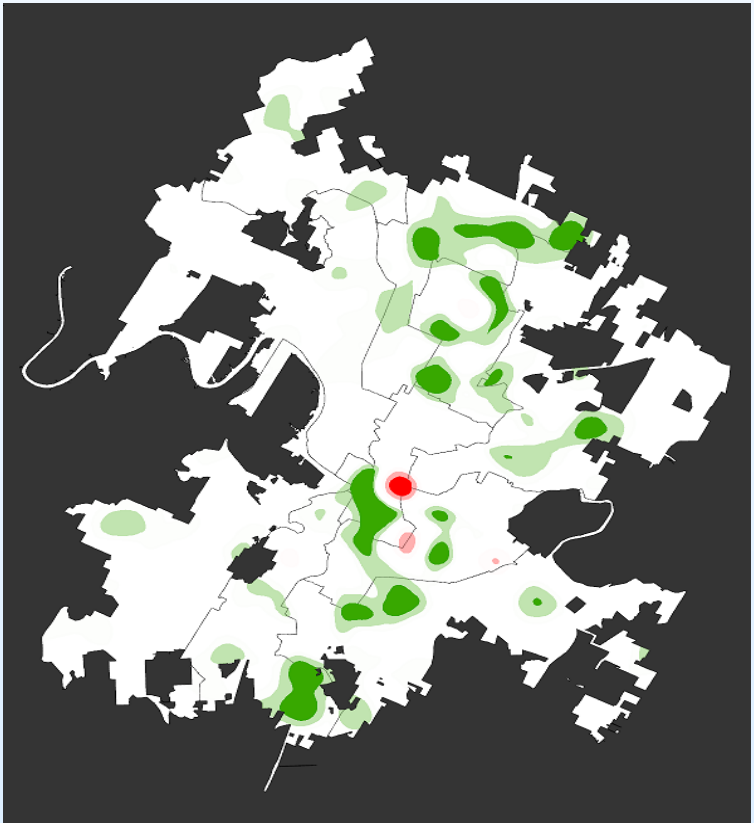

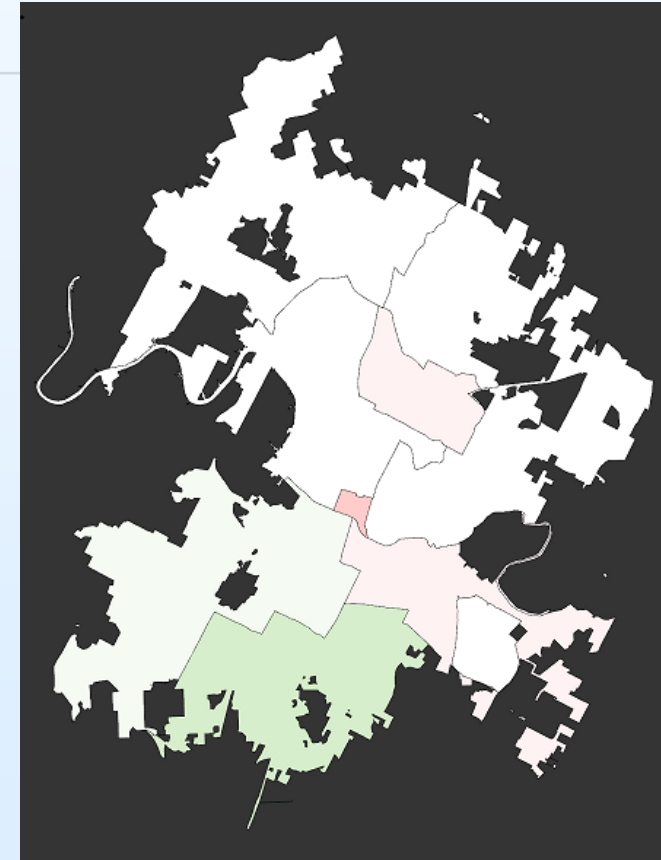

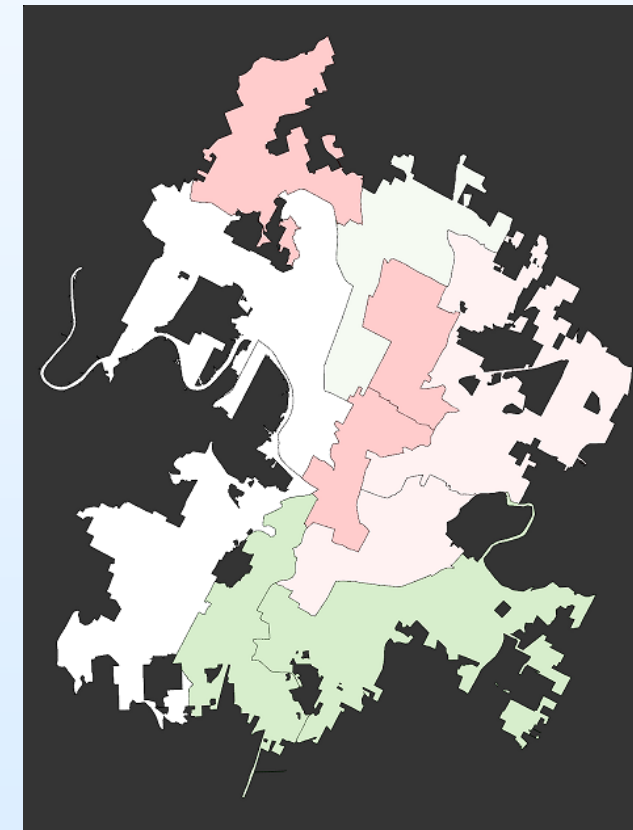

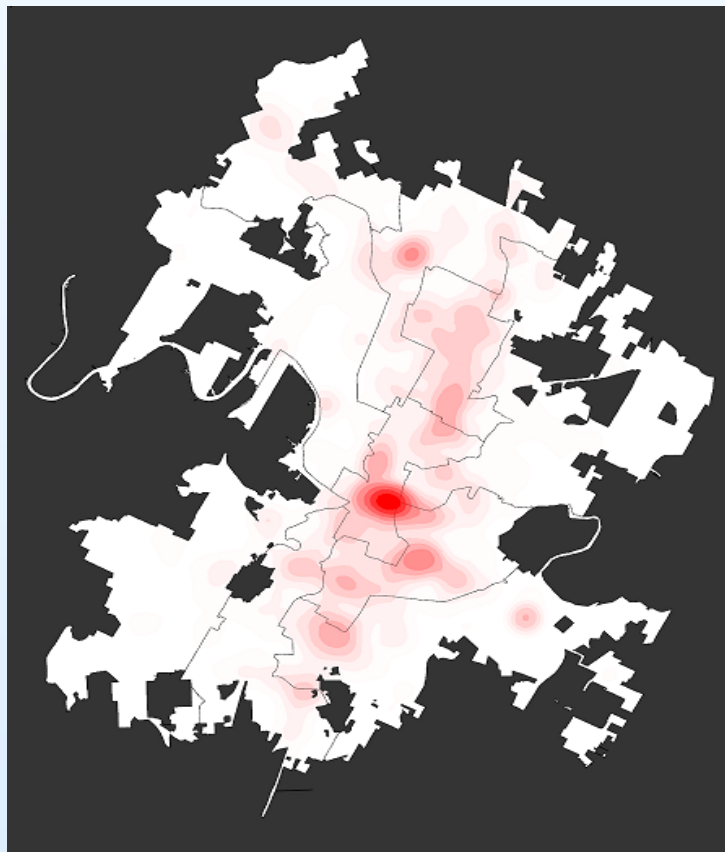

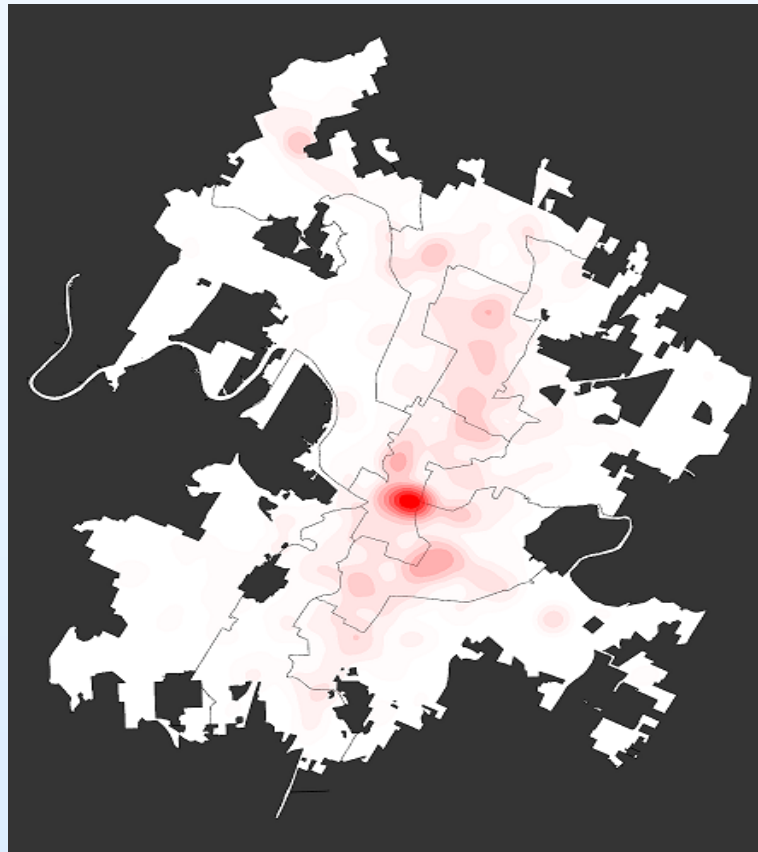

Crimes Against Property/Society Density (“Hotspots”)

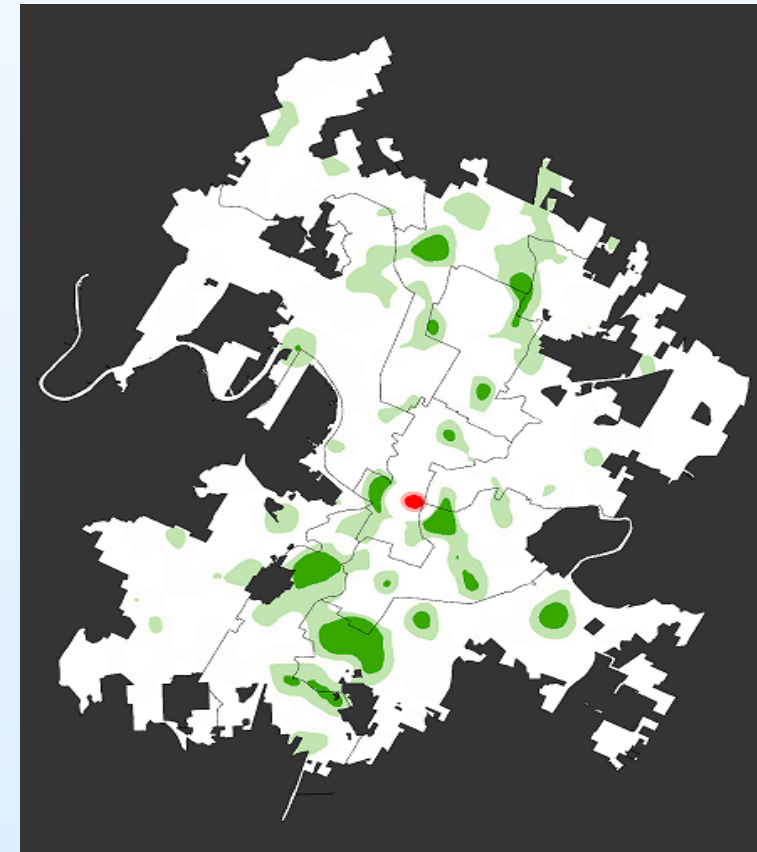

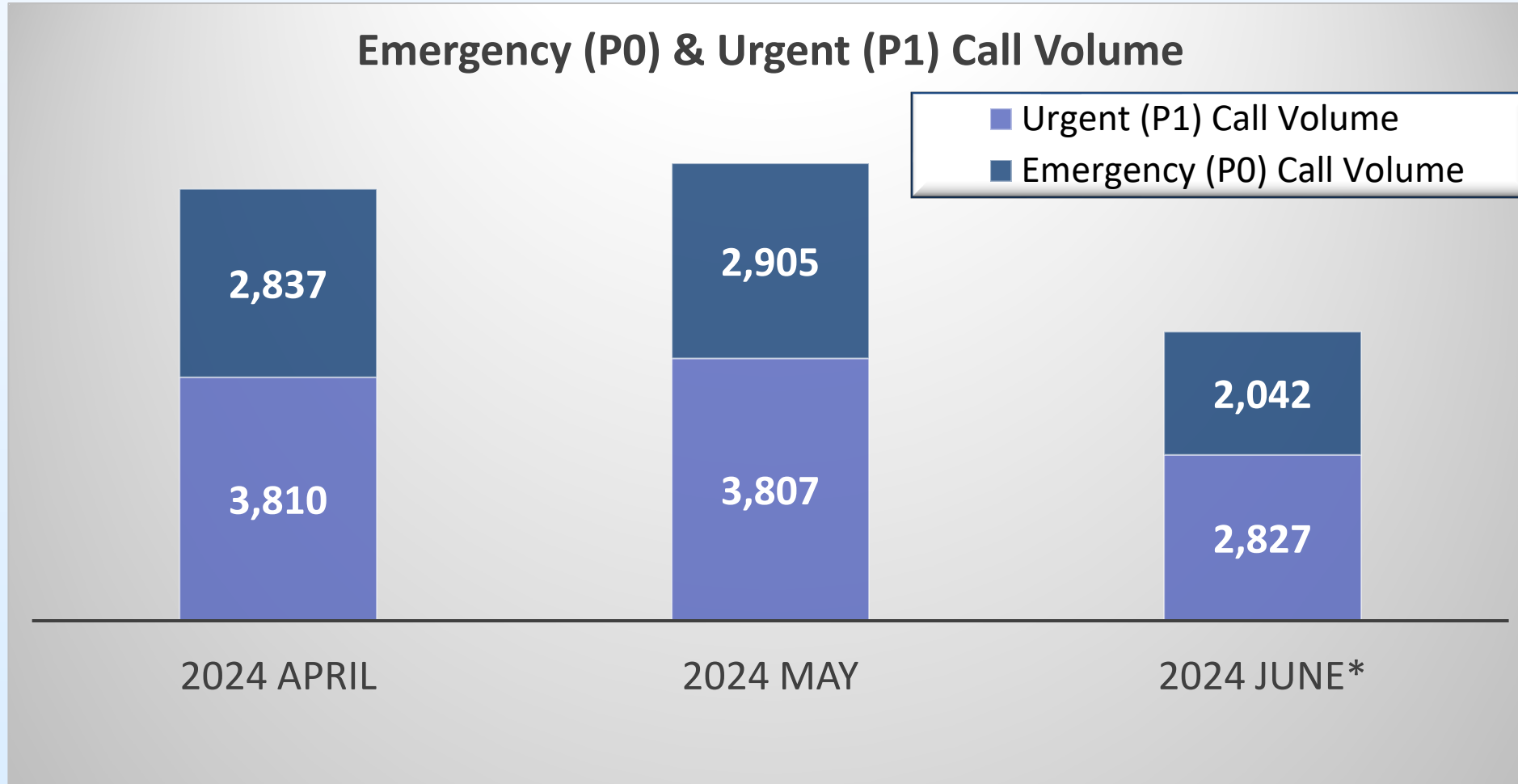

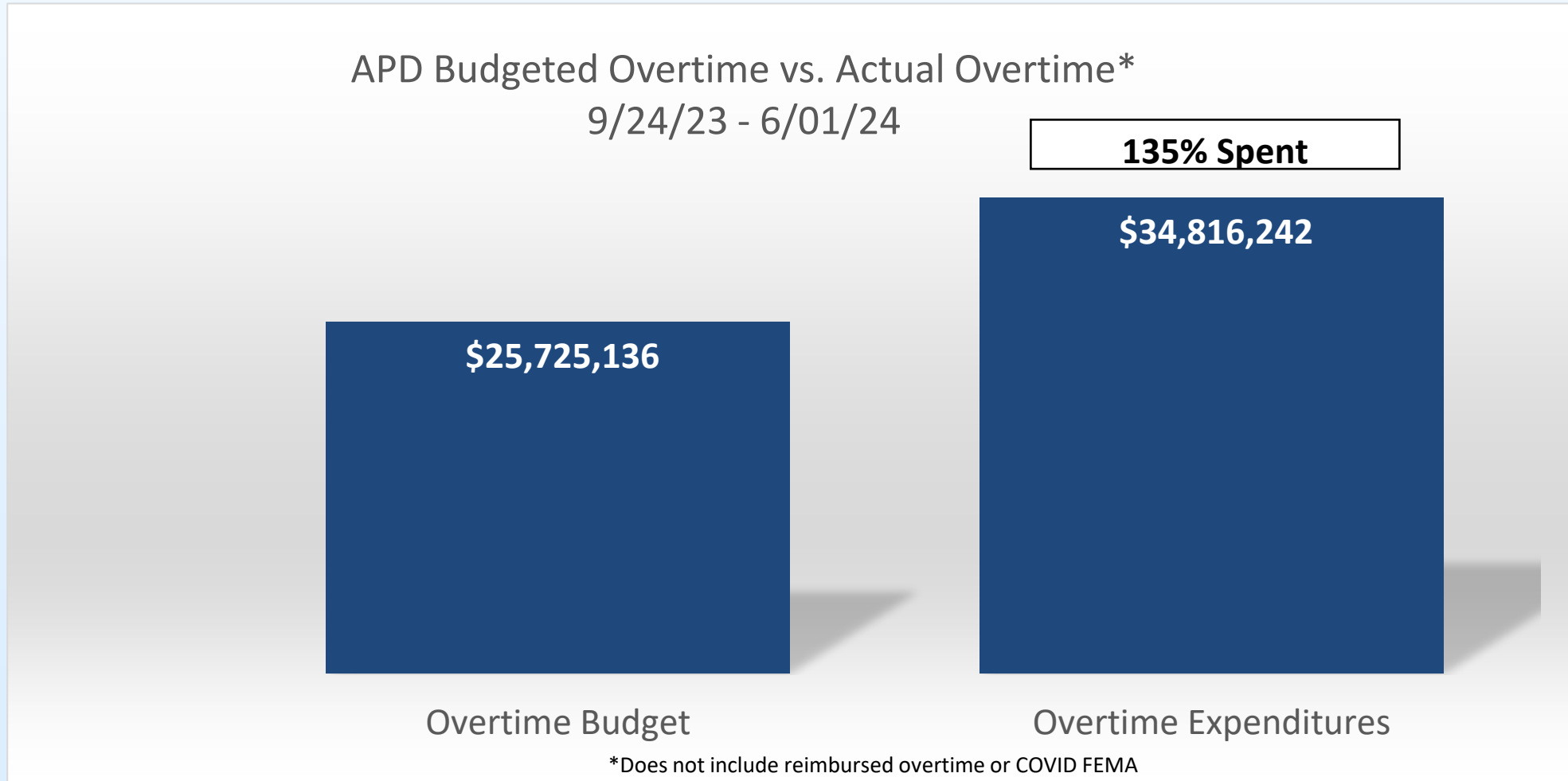

2023-Sep-24 through 2024-Jun-1

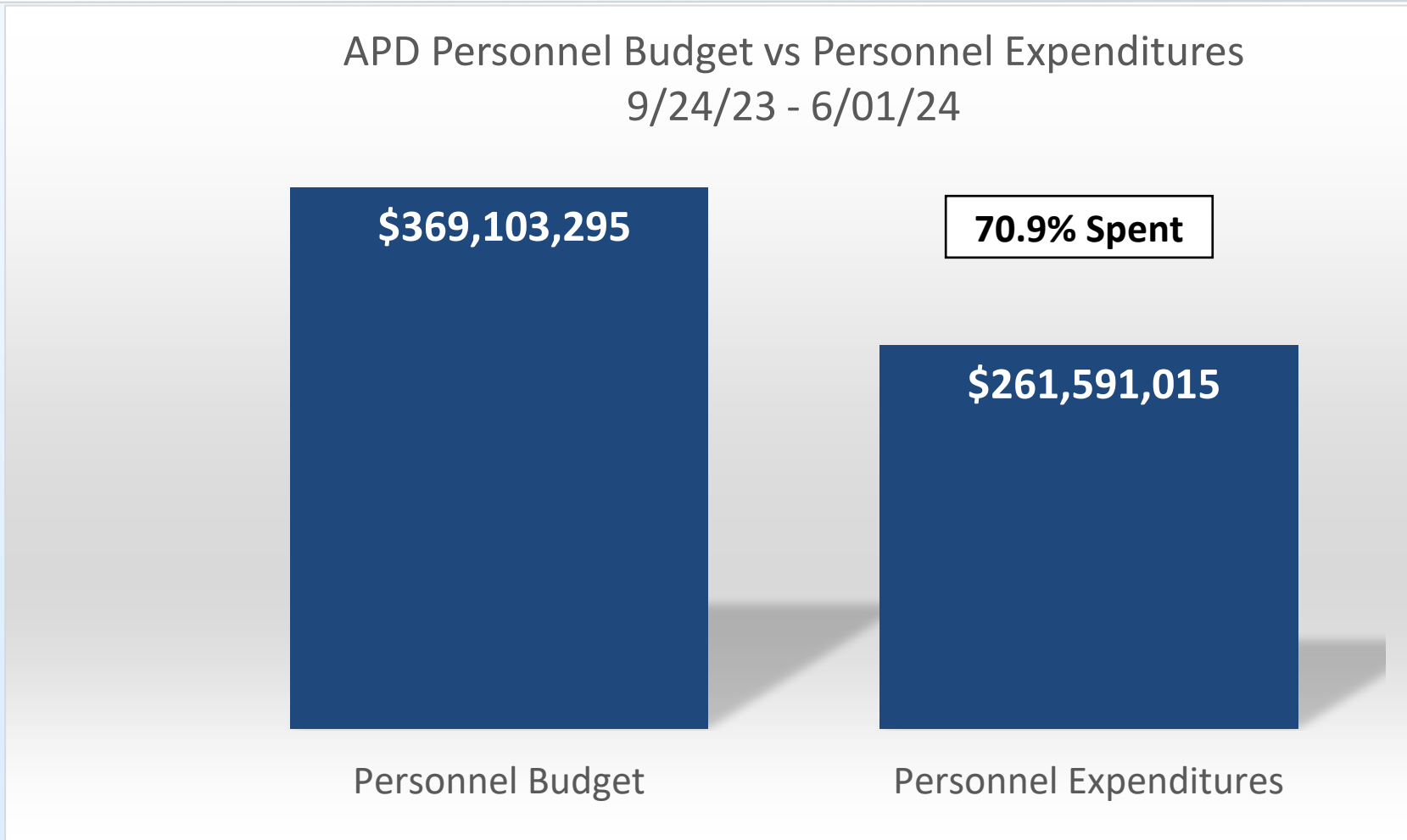

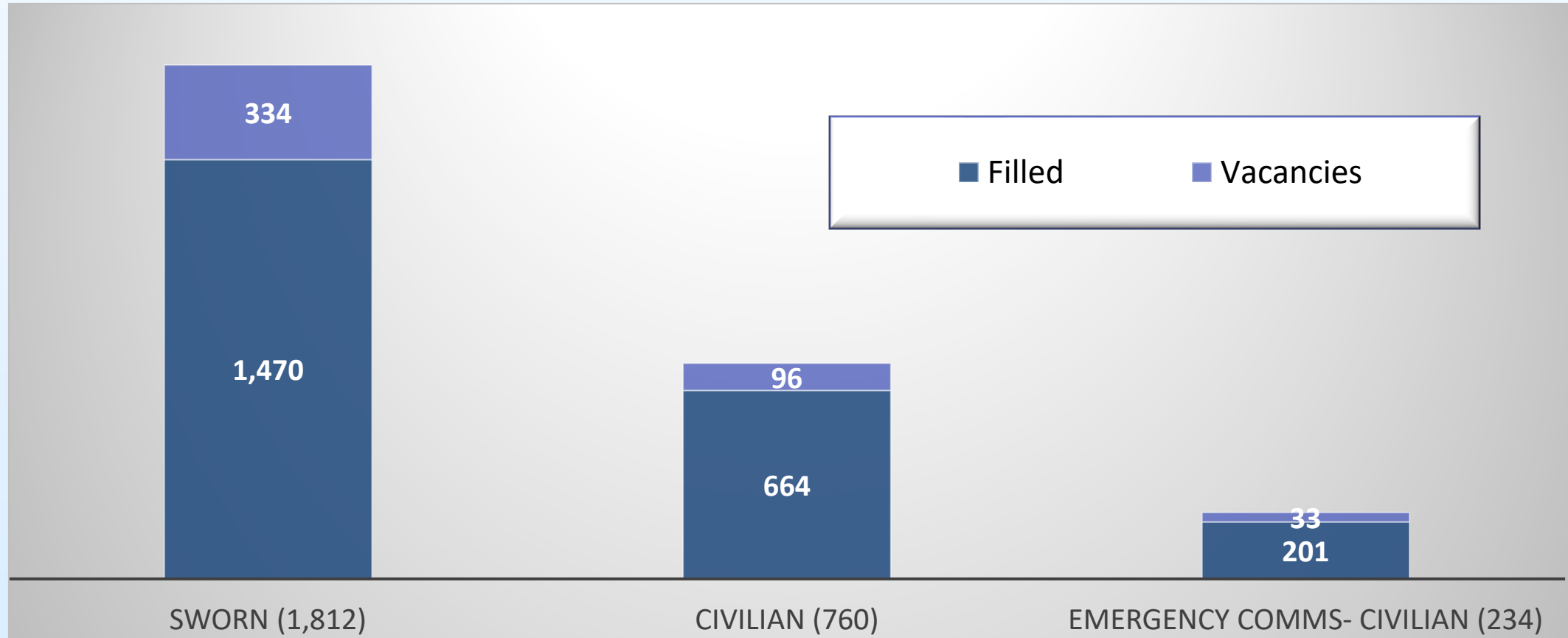

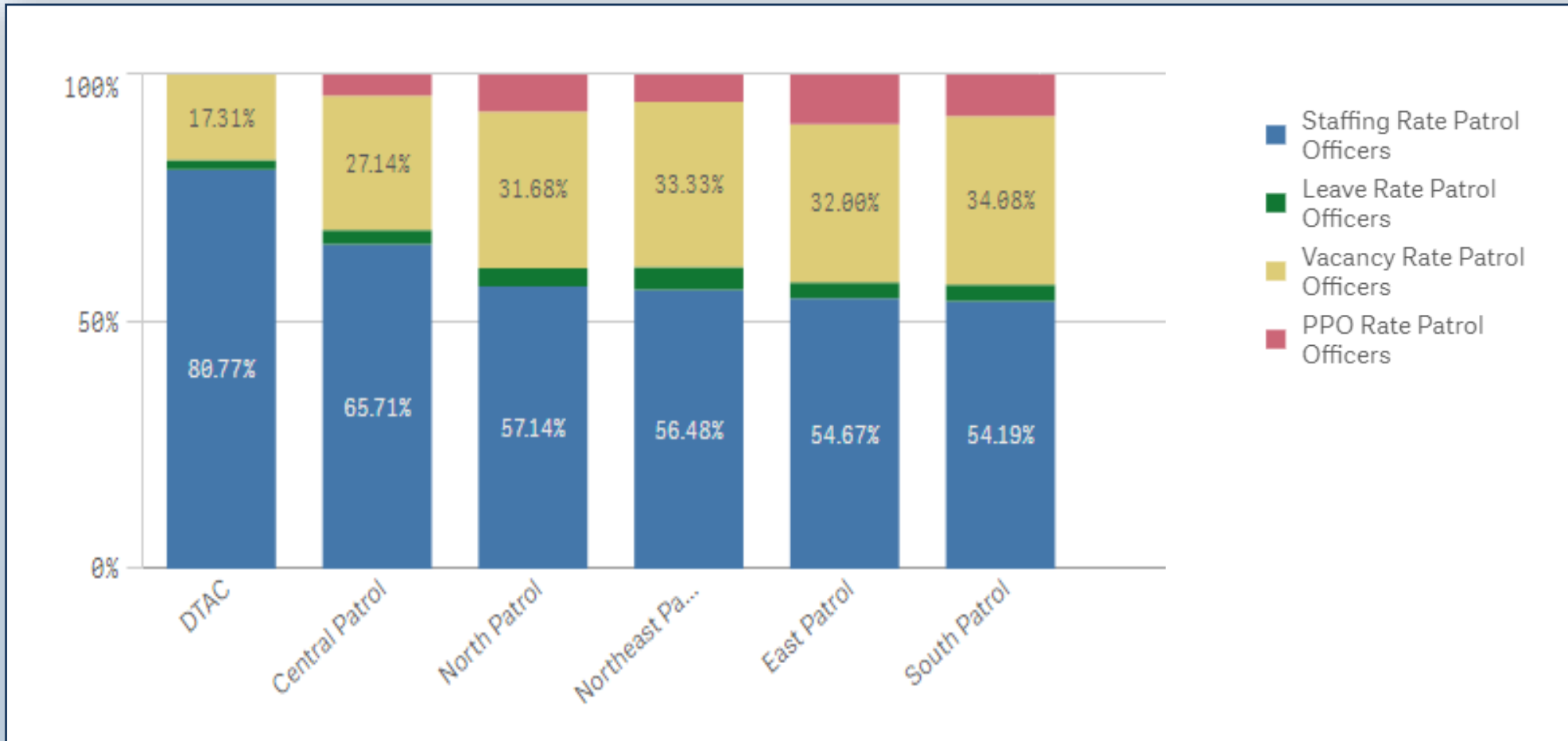
Staffing levels

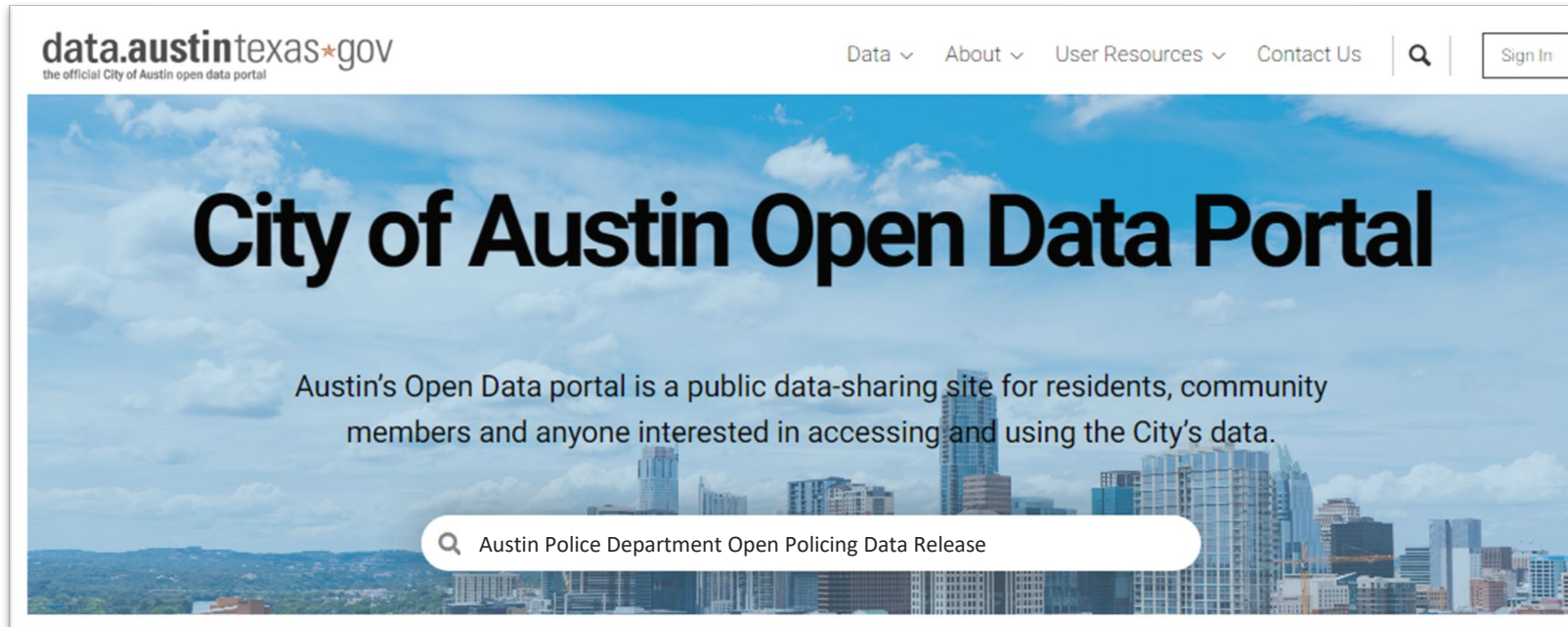

National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS)

As of January 1, 2019, the Austin Police Department began operating as a Uniform Crime Reporting National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) reporting agency. This dynamic dashboard collects and categorizes crimes reported by individuals, affecting property, and impacting society from January 1, 2020, onward. Updated on a monthly basis, the data encompasses entire months, ensuring the most current and comprehensive information.

For optimal experience, it's recommended to access this dashboard using a computer or laptop. Utilizing these devices will enable access to useful tooltips and the capability to interact with the visualizations.



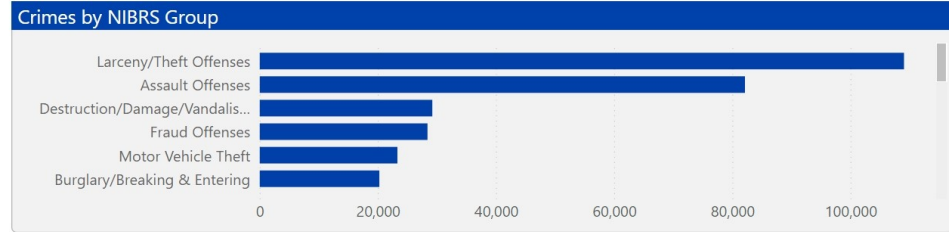
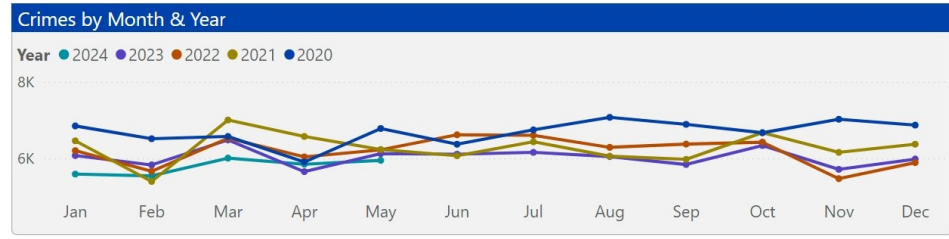
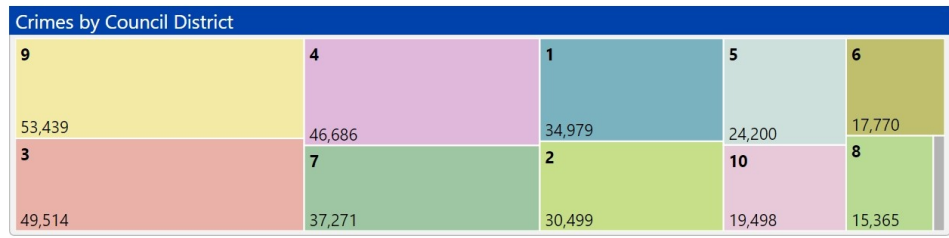
