

ORDINANCE NO. 20240829-108

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF THE NORTH VILLAGE BRANCH LIBRARY TO THE JOHN GILLUM BRANCH LIBRARY AND WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTIONS 14-1-32 AND 14-1-34 OF THE CITY CODE REGARDING THE NAMING OR RENAMING OF A FACILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. John Gillum was employed by the Austin Public Library from 1979 until his retirement in 2019, dedicating 39 years, 11 months, and 16 days to his service with the City. Mr. Gillum served as the Facilities Planning Manager and later as the Facilities Process Manager, overseeing every aspect of the planning design, construction, and renovation of all Austin Public Library facilities and playing a significant role in the relocation and development of the North Village Branch Library.

PART 2. The requirements of Sections 14-1-32 (*Naming Policy*) and 14-1-34 (*Procedure for Renaming a Facility*) of the Code are waived for the naming of the North Village Branch Library.


PART 3. The North Village Branch Library is renamed the John Gillum Branch Library.

PART 4. This ordinance takes effect on September 9, 2024.




