September 22, 1959

The meeting was called to order with Mayor Miller presiding.

Roll call:

The Mayor announced that this was a meeting called for the purpose of requesting confirmation of the Missouri Pacific Railroad for right-of-way on each side of their tracks from approximately 5th Street to Northland Drive.

Councilman Palmer moved that the City Council formally request from the Missouri Pacific Railroad that they deed to the City of Austin a strip of land on each side of the Missouri Pacific Tracks, of sufficient widths to provide a roadway on each side of their present tracks to provide for a boulevard from approximately 5th Street north to Northland Drive. The motion, seconded by Councilman Bechtol, carried by the following vote:
