General Orders

- General Order 328
 - It is the policy and practice of APD to provide services and enforce the law equally, fairly, and without discrimination toward any individual or group.
- General Order 330
 - Refers to interactions with individuals who are foreign nationals or immigrants and with immigration authorities.
 - Intended to increase officer effectiveness when protecting the entire community, regardless of national origin or immigration status.

Data Transparency

- APD tracks officer inquiries into immigration status. These instances occur rarely.
