Limits on Locations for Signs on ROW Installations

I move to add the underlined text to Part 4 of the draft ordinance.

PART 4. City Code Chapter 25-10, Article 5 (Regulations Applicable to All Sign Districts) is amended to add a new Section 25-10-105 to read:

§ 25-10-105 SIGNS AUTHORIZED ON RIGHT-OF-WAY INSTALLATIONS.

- (A) A sign authorized by this section includes an off-premise sign.
- (B) A sign may be installed on a right-of-way installation in accordance with this section.
- (C) A sign installed on a right-of-way installation may not:
 - (1) exceed 86 inches measured diagonally; or
 - (2) be located on public right-of-way that is adjacent to:
 - (a) single family residence large lot (SF-1) district;
 - (b) single family residence standard lot (SF-2) district; or
 - (c) family residence (SF-3) district.
- (D) The director of Austin Transportation and Public Works is authorized to adopt administrative rules that apply to signs installed on a right-of-way installation. At a minimum, these rules should address placement, orientation, lighting, and speed of images.
