

.. Regular meeting of the City Council ; Austin, Texas , June 11th 1914.

The Council was called to order by the Mayor: Roll called :

June 13th 1914.

The Council was called to order by the Mayor with all members present :

Councilman Powell offered the following resolution :

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin , that the City Treasurer be requested , and hereby instructed to transfer the sum of one hundred and seventy four dollars (\$ 174.00) from General street fund to Permanent street improvement fund, for the purpose of re-imbursing said fund for this amount which was erroneously drawn _ See warrant No 3625.

That the Assessor & Collector of taxes of the City of Austin, Texas, in settling with the said V O Weed for taxes due on 120 feet across the south part of lots 9 & 12, in block 2 Outlet 11 Div "Z", of the City of Austin, Texas, shall charge neither interest nor penalties against said property beyond the 9th day of January 1914, provided that promptly upon the passage of this resolution , all taxes owing by the said V O Weed are paid in full.
